with Jonathan Stern of San Francisco State University After an absence of 65 years, harbor porpoises have returned to San Francisco Bay. This talk will focus on the historical use of San Francisco Bay by harbor porpoises, the causes of their leaving, and speculate on the reasons of their return. The ecological implications of the return of this predator to the Bay will also be discussed. Jonathan Stern, a **TLHS alumnus**, has studied minke whales since 1980, and is currently a Co-Principal Investigator at Golden Gate Cetacean Research.
