MARIN SCIENCE SEMINAR INTERNSHIPS

- Science Journalism, Videography, Multimedia, Audio-visual, Social Media
- Open to all Marin County Students in grades 9 - college
- Required: Attendance at 6 Wednesday evening sessions per semester (7 – 8:45pm), specific requirements for different internship types
- Location: Terra Linda HS, Innovation Hub, 320 Nova Albion, San Rafael

Since 2008, Marin Science Seminar (MSS) brings working scientists, engineers, medical professionals, and computer programmers to speak to high school students twelve times a year. Students learn what STEM professionals really do. MSS also provides information on local science events, and manages several social networking sites.

Internship:

Explore science, develop a portfolio, educate others. MSS interns **attend and assist with 6 Wednesday evening science seminars per semester** during which they meet the speakers and help run the program. Interns attend from 7 – **8:45 pm**. All interns assist with set-up, intake, and AV duties. They leave once breakdown is completed after 8:30 pm, no later than 9 pm. Journalism interns interview speakers via email, and blog and post about speakers and event topics. Videography interns record sessions in 2D & 360VR, create teaser videos and post videos. Both may act as content managers for MSS's social media outlets. Multimedia and Social Media internships are also available. We provide training for all internship duties but interns are expected to have the basic skills for their internship type. See details below.

- Application Requirements: Writing interns submit two original writing samples. Videography interns submit two original video samples. They do not have to deal with science. Interns must have regular access to email and the Internet. All prospective interns are interviewed in person or via Zoom.
